#### **WHY YOUR PRESENCE MATTERS:**

Recent statistics from the Florida Department of Health show that Broward County is second in the number of HIV Case Rates in the State of Florida. This coupled with the fact that of the sexually transmitted diseases reported in Florida in 2013, 26% of Chlamydia, 19% of Gonorrhea and 6% of Primary and Secondary Syphilis cases were among persons aged between 13-19, sound alarms that more strategic intervention is needed to address the real plight of our youth. Living in communities with high levels of poverty, unemployment, and crime; poor-quality housing, social exclusion, low levels of education, exposure to HIV and STIs, continue to contribute to the plethora of social realities that plague our community and Broward County youth in particular.
